READ 3 READ IN OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. All entries must be received by September 29, 2022. Open to Texas 501(c)(3) organizations only. Void where prohibited.

- 1. **PROGRAM PERIOD.** The entry period for the Read 3 Read In (the "Award Program"), sponsored by H-E-B, LP ("H-E-B" or "Sponsor"), begins on September 7, 2022 at 12:00:01 a.m. Central Standard Time ("CST") and ends on September 29, 2022, at 11:59:59 p.m. CST ("Award Program Period").
